Australian Mathematics Competition: 9 August 2018
Years 3 – 6

The Australian Mathematics Competition (AMC) was introduced in Australia in 1978 as the first Australia-wide mathematics competition for students. It has since spread internationally, with students in more than 30 countries attempting the same problems.

The AMC is for students of all standards. Students are asked to solve 30 problems in 60 minutes (Years 3–6). The problems are designed to test mathematical thinking and questions are designed so that they can be answered just as quickly without a calculator as with one. The problems get more difficult through the competition, so that at the end they are challenging to the most gifted students. Students of all standards will make progress through the problems, and also be challenged along the way.

Students will complete the competition under examination conditions at school on 9 August.

The Australian Mathematics Trust advises that:

- In order to keep the entry fee as low as possible, they cannot refund any entry fees (\$6.50) once materials have been sent to schools. This includes entry fees paid for students who, for whatever reason, do not end up sitting the competition.
- **The registration date cannot be extended. All registrations and payments must be received no later than Thursday, 14 June.**
