As part of the Term 2 inquiry unit, 'The business of helping others', Year 6 students will be going on an excursion on **Tuesday 01 May, 2018** to establish and consolidate their understanding of key economic concepts.

The day will begin with a guided tour of The Queen Victoria Market, including a question and answer time with selected local traders. This experience is designed to support students' understandings of the business environment, including reasoning as to why businesses might exist and the different ways in which they produce and distribute goods and services.

The students will then continue to the Melbourne Museum to participate in the 'Making a Quid' exhibition. This interactive exhibition is specifically designed for Year 5-6 students and explores the nature of how work has changed over time, the impact of technology in the working world, and the subsequent impact of changing work on the environment.

As we would all recognise, early morning is best time to experience any market! For this reason, the bus will depart from Clarke Street at **8.30am**, in order to arrive at Queen Victoria Market by 9.00am. Therefore, we ask that students assemble in the gym to have the roll marked **by no later than 8.25am**.

If students are attending before care, a staff member will collect them from the Farmhouse at 8.20am.

Buses will take students from the Queen Victoria Market to the Melbourne Museum at around 10:30am and, latterly, collect students from the Museum at 2.30pm to arrive back at Westgarth Primary School by 3.00pm.
